School Illness Policy - Parent's Please Read!

With the increase in the flu, strep, fevers, etc. going around in our community, we want you to be aware of school policy.

If your child has had a fever, been vomiting or has diarrhea, they must remain home from school until it has been 24 hrs since the fever broke without taking Tylenol or Ibuprofen or it has been 24 hours since they last vomited or had a bout with diarrhea.

For example, if your child was running a fever on Sunday morning and the fever broke (without further medication) at 1:00 pm on Sunday afternoon, they may not come back to school until 1:00 pm on Monday.

If your child has pink eye or a yellow/green discharge from the nose, medication must be given 24 hrs before they can return to class from the initial dose.

We want to keep our students and staff as healthy as possible. By bringing your child to school with any of these symptoms puts others at risk for catching these. If you are in doubt, please call the school office or talk with your child's teacher before sending them to school.

Medication use at school: If your child requires medication of any form, like cough drops, cough medicine, Tylenol, etc., you must bring it to the school office and fill out a Medication Release Form. Doses will be administered as you suggest on the form. Students may not administer medication on their own.

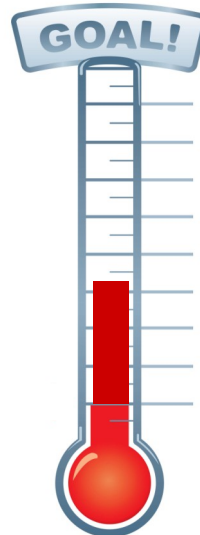
