Nebraska-nauts

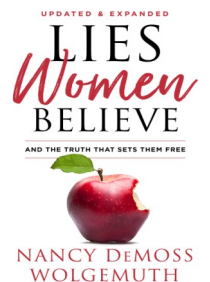

Bible: 2 Timothy 2:15: Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman who has nothing to be ashamed of, rightly dividing the word of truth. How can we learn to rightly divide the word of truth? Outside of first seeking the Holy Spirit to help us read and understand the Word of God, the students will be learning to equip themselves with such tangible Bible tools as concordances, time lines, maps, Bible commentaries and online searches. The adage that says, “Give a man a fish and you feed him for a day. Teach a man to fish and you feed him for a lifetime” applies also to the teaching of God’s Word and it’s timeless truths for our lives.

Our class had the opportunity to learn from another instructor from the 4H Extension office. Our class was Ag and Me. Ms. Aliesha will led the class in understanding what ag commodities create the foods they eat everyday. The class worked to gather to make a class book that will be shown at Platte County Fair Summer 2022.

In Science we are all studying seeds. Kindergarten is matching the seed to the plant it produces. Kindergarteners may bring in a seed or seed packet to share with the class. 1st and 2nd grade is conducting an experiment to see if their seed grows better with or without water. It has been exciting to check on the seeds daily in our classroom window.

Library Day is moving to Fridays! We have decided to include library checkout in our Fun Friday routine. Fun Fridays we also get to read with stuffies, listen to stories during quiet time, and complete artwork.

We are memorizing Genesis 50-20 this week. Our last verse took two weeks to memorize. I gave each student two copies of the verse this week. One copy can stay here for daily practice. Their other copy should be taken home to practice with you. This week has been busy at CCS. The 4/5 grades learned about insects and spiders. The 3rd grade experimented with temperature. They both have a test in Science this coming Tuesday. I have sent home flashcards for each to study in preparation. We are beginning a new chapter in English. Worship & Drama Team

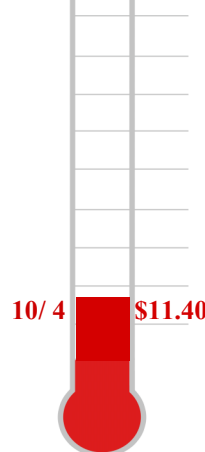
Worship team is continuing to practice and lead our students during chapel. They are also beginning to learn the music which will be performed at the Christmas Program.
